Companies remain pessimistic, with a positive trend recently

The business confidence indicator (BCI) provides information on future developments, based upon opinion surveys on developments in production, orders and stocks of finished goods in the industry sector. Numbers above 100 suggest an increased confidence in near future business performance, and numbers below 100 indicate pessimism towards future performance. It can be used to monitor output growth and to anticipate turning points in economic activity.

Consumer confidence remains negative, with a slightly positive trend

The consumer confidence indicator (CCI) provides an indication of future developments of households' consumption and saving, based upon answers regarding their expected financial situation, their sentiment about the general economic situation, unemployment and capability of savings. An indicator above 100 signals a boost in the consumers' confidence towards the future economic situation. Values below 100 indicate a pessimistic attitude towards future developments.



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
